### **Clinical Associate Professor Hilary Blacklock (Chair)**

*Hilary Anne Blacklock, MBChB (Otago), FRACP, FRCPA.*

Hilary Blacklock is Clinical Head of the Clinical Haematology Department at Middlemore Hospital, Auckland. Other appointments include Medical Director of the New Zealand Bone Marrow Donor Registry, Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Molecular Medicine at the Auckland School of Medicine and she is a Trustee of the Leukaemia and Blood Foundation of New Zealand. Hilary is active in clinical research and has 70 publications in peer reviewed journals.

### **Professor Peter Browett**

*Peter Browett BMedSci, MBChB (Otago), FRACP, FRCPA.*

Prof Browett is a Consultant Haematologist at Auckland City Hospital, and Professor of Pathology and Chair of the Department of Molecular Medicine and Pathology, Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences, University of Auckland. Peter is involved in several co-operative group and institution initiated studies in haematologic malignancies and stem cell transplantation. His research interests include genetics of thrombosis and bleeding, molecular markers in leukaemia and the role of PI3 kinase signalling in acute myeloid leukaemia. Peter is on the Board of the Auckland Medical Research Foundation and is a Trustee of the Leukaemia and Blood Foundation.

### **Professor Kathy Crosier**

*Kathryn Crosier ONZM, MBChB, PhD, FRACP, FRCPA.*

Prof Crosier is Professor of Molecular Medicine at The University of Auckland where she directs the Developmental and Cancer Genetics Research Laboratory, and is a Haematologist at Auckland City Hospital. She joined the Faculty of The University of Auckland following a Fellowship undertaken at the Children's Hospital and Harvard Medical School, Boston. Kathryn has served on the Boards of

the Institute of Environmental Science and Research and the New Zealand Blood Service.

### **Dr Michael Dray**

*Michael Dray MBChB (Otago), DCH, Dip Obst, FRCPA.*

Dr Dray is a Consultant Histopathologist at Middlemore Hospital. His initial medical career saw him in General Practice for several years. Michael has several publications to his name and research interests in the areas of bone, joint and soft tissue pathology, bone histomorphometry, breast pathology, ENT/ORL pathology, and dermatopathology.

### **Associate Professor Andrew Hill**

*Andrew Hill MBChB (Auckland), MD, FRACS (general surgery)*

A. Prof Hill is a general surgeon with a colorectal subspecialty interest. His research interests are clinical and translational research in general surgery including improving perioperative care of the surgical patient and undergraduate medical education. He is the Head of the Auckland Enhanced Recovery after Surgery (AERAS) research group and Head of the South Auckland Clinical School at Middlemore Hospital. Andrew is also interested in how the learning environment can be improved for medical students and the role of junior doctors in undergraduate medical education.

### **Associate Professor Cristin Print**

*Cristin Print MBChB (Auckland), PhD.*

A. Prof Print worked as a house surgeon and performed asthma research in Dunedin before completing a PhD at Auckland University. He worked for 4 years at the Walter and Elisa Hall Institute in Melbourne, and for 6 years at Cambridge University in England. In 2005 he returned to the University of Auckland, where he is an Associate Professor of Pathology and Director of the New Zealand Bioinformatics Institute. Most of his academic and commercial work has focused on molecular pathways and networks in pathology.
